All services are confidential and free of charge. Call the 24-hour line at 703-777-6552 for further information about support groups. Services are provided at the Community Services Center.

Services Provided:

- Short-term crisis counseling and support
- Counseling and support for secondary victims (ie, family members of the sexual assault victim)
- Sexual assault support groups
- Court accompaniment
- Accompaniment to forensic medical exams
- Safety planning
- Information and referral to community resources
- Assistance filing protective orders
- Other advocacy and assistance as needed
