Crime Prevention includes Information about Neighborhood Watch, Home and Business Security Survey, Crime Solvers, D.A.R.E., Problem-Orientated Policing, Senior Call Back, Safety Patrol and Children Fingerprinting, as well as Animal Control license and information.
