Call about the different entrance fee plans. The monthly fee includes all utilities except telephone, 30 meals per month per person for Independent Living and three meals a day for other levels of care; cable TV; weekly housekeeping; inside and outside maintenance; linen service weekly; security 24 hours; emergency call system; trash removal; wellness program including a fitness center and heated indoor pool; transportation to social, recreational and medical appointments; onsite pharmacy and banking; elegant or casual dining; various support groups and spiritual life are also offered.

Accredited by the Continuing Care Accreditation Commission (CCAC) and EAGLE Accreditation, a voluntary self-assessment and peer review process designed to enhance the quality of services provided at church-related, not-for-profit ministries.
